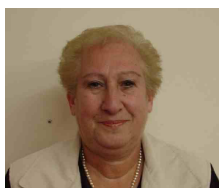

S137 (Grants)	£ 5436.00
Subs and insurance	£ 5439.58
Wages and audit	£ 10914.06
Rates & overheads	£ 14449.24
Outside maintenance	£23945.98
Repairs & renewals	£ 52.28
Vat	£ 7599.08

Total expenditure for the 6 month period was £74437.51 Total expenditure for the whole year 2007-2008 was £109962.61
Based on these figures the recommended precept for 2009-2010 was agreed at £126075.00

Butcher's Field (near the famous Pevensey Castle)

This was purchased in 2002 by Westham Parish Council to commemorate the Queen's Golden Jubilee and has recently been used to graze sheep. At the far end of the field there is a commemorative stone to celebrate the life of the late John Vincent. There are benches in the field so that residents can enjoy the views of the Castle.

Over the coming years it is hoped that some work will be undertaken in order to restore the soil so that suitable meadow plants can be reinstated.
