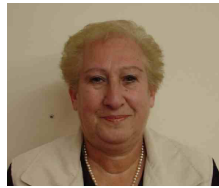

Wealden District Council is undertaking a Community Governance Review to consider the boundaries and electoral arrangements of the parishes of Pevensey and Westham. As part of this review, Pevensey Parish Council has requested that Wealden District Council consider two amendments to the boundary between the Pevensey and Westham parishes. This includes the boundary westwards along Langney Sewer to the Eastbourne boundary which would be the western end of the Castle View Caravan Park field. The boundary would then follow the Eastbourne boundary to the beach on the road beside the golf course and Bay View Camp-Site. This proposal would affect properties within the following roads in the Westham Parish - Eastbourne Road, Grey Tower Road and Old Martello Road. OTHER NEWS

Adur Park

At the Full Council Meeting in November the Parish Council asked the Clerk to get works in Adur Park:



- 1: To remove the shrub and trees at the Friday Street end, where there have been anti social problems.
- 2: To cut the shrubs at the far end behind the swings to 1m high.
- 3: To remove the existing entrance on Friday Street and make good with a new vehicular access to be constructed in front of the newly cleared trees.
- 4: For the hedging at the Friday Street end to be removed and new fencing installed up to the new entrance.

Westham Pond

At the Full Council meeting in November the Parish Council accepted Westham Pond Working Party's recommendations that the debris from the pond is cleared that some of the trees are cut back and the brambles and willow branches are removed.



The Parish Council agreed that the area needs to retain its rural environment and its habitat for flora and fauna and that any clearance needs to be carried out as soon as possible. The Parish Council has now given the go ahead for the work to be carried out.
