WESTHAM POND

The Parish Council agreed last year that the Pond required urgent attention provided that the natural environment was retained for the flora and fauna. Many thanks to the contractors who completed the work and who also managed to clear the rubbish that had been deposited in the pond.



ADUR RECREATION PARK ON FRIDAY STREET

The Full Parish Council Meeting in November agreed to:

- remove the large shrubs and trees at Friday Street and provide a new vehicular entrance (the entrance is subject to a planning application)
- cut the hedging down at the far end behind the swings to 1m high
- remove the existing entrance on Friday Street and make good
- remove the overgrown hedging at the Friday Street end and replace with fencing up to the new entrance.

As you can see this work has now begun.
